My duties as Historian will be modify the criteria of entries for the Irish History Contest to include not only a writing document but other media platforms i.e.: PowerPoint presentations, documentary/Film presentations. I will be creating a brochure to include the new formats accepted including the name change to **Irish History Contest**.

During the National History Committee for the 2020 convention, a motion was passed that a one-time assessment of \$1.00 will be assessed on all members. The total amount due will be based on the 2020 annual membership reports. This assessment is to offset costs associated with the marker at the Nuns of the Battlefield site in Washington, DC. In addition, the proceeds from the sale of the LAOH History Book will also be applied to the marker costs. Dedication of the marker is expected in 2024.
