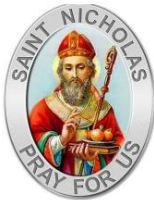

# St. Nicholas Day December 6th

Did you know the tomb of Saint Nicholas is in Ireland? Located in County Kilkenny, Ireland, it lies in the medieval lost town of Newtown. It is on the grounds of the privately owned Jerpoint Park. St. Nicholas's Church and graveyard are in the town, where the earthly remains of St. Nicholas of Myra are said to be buried. The grave slab features St. Nicholas with the heads of two knights said to be the heads of the two crusader knights who brought his remains to Ireland. St. Nicholas was reputed to have given marriage dowries of gold to three girls whom poverty would otherwise have forced into lives of prostitution and to have restored to life three children who had been chopped up by a butcher and put in a tub of brine.

In the Middle Ages, devotion to Nicholas extended to all parts of Europe. Today, Nicholas is considered the patron saint of sailors and children. December 6th marks the anniversary of the death of the third-century Catholic saint who inspired the modern versions of Santa Claus.
