Greetings Everyone:

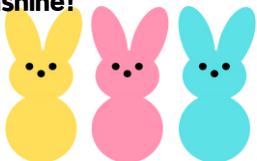

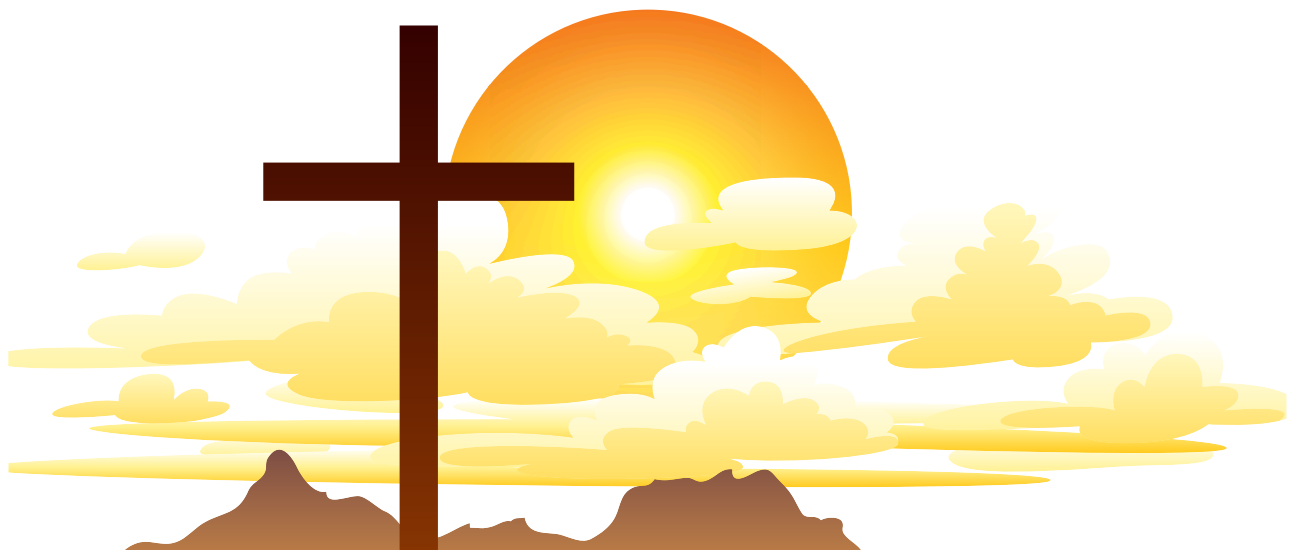
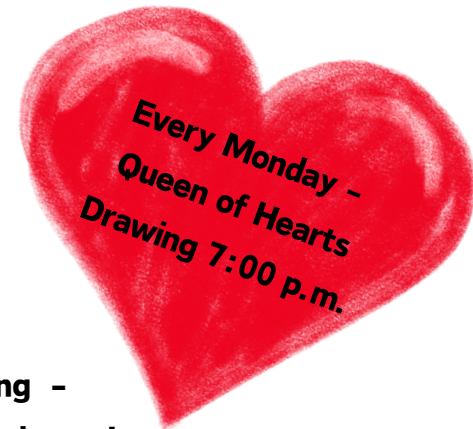

HOW IT WORKS

1. Participants purchase paddles for a donation.
2. Each paddle has a corresponding numbered chip that goes into a drawing basket.
3. Vendors display items for auction.
4. The announcer calls out the number of quarters needed to bid on an item.
5. Participants put the correct number of quarters into a bucket for each paddle they want to use.
6. The announcer draws a number from the basket.
7. If the drawn number matches a paddle that's being held up, that participant wins the item.

OTHER DETAILS:

- Participants can purchase additional paddles for a donation.
- Some quarter auctions also include raffles, food, drinks, and door prizes.
- Participants can bid on items with one or two quarters, depending on the item's bid price.

President Woodrow Wilson signed a proclamation declaring Mother's Day an official holiday on May 9, 1914.

Memorial Day, originally called Decoration Day, originated after the Civil War to honor those who died in service, evolved into a national holiday in 1971, and now commemorates all American veterans who have died.
