

It has been a privilege to serve as the National Missions & Charities Officer over the last two years. I did my best to uphold my promise to be responsive, engaged and committed to supporting the order in my position during my term. It has been a pleasure to get to meet many of you either via phone, email, text, zoom or in person. I truly appreciated when you reached out to me with questions as it helped me just as much to get settled in my new position.

At the Interim Board meeting in September of 2025, the membership voted to round up the number being donated for our missions and the following donations were mailed out: Columban Fathers \$17,500; Columban Father Mass Stipend \$6,955; Columban Sisters \$21,100; Columban Sisters 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary \$5,500 for a total of \$51,055.

As you know, donations will still be coming in after this report is written. We have until June 30<sup>th</sup> to deposit donations that will be reflected in the final report at the National Convention. Please remember, any donations received after June 30<sup>th</sup> will be reflected in the next Mission & Charities Officer report. Donations collected after the Interim Board Meeting to date of this report (June 18<sup>th</sup>) in the Missions & Charities Account, totals \$35,376.80. The breakdown is as follows: Columban Fathers, \$13,392.95; Columban Sisters \$15,963.85 (this includes \$600 in 100 anniversary donations that came in after the interim board meeting); Columban Father's Mass Stipends, \$6,020.00. Since contributions are still coming in that will be a total of over \$86,431.80 in donations during this term, bravo ladies! As a point of reference on how each state did individually, please see attached report with a breakdown by charity/year/total and then per capita. Again, please note I did not include the month of June in the attached report as we are still collecting donations.

Unfortunately, we have not been able to schedule a visit to the Columban's location while in Omaha. With the Constitutional Convention and all the other meetings, we could not make it happen. Fortunately, Fr. Al Utzig, US Region Director of the Columban Fathers will be our keynote speaker at our General Session on Friday. This will give everyone an opportunity to meet him and the team in person. We are also happy to have Fr. Al and Sister Corona Colleary as our honored guests at the Irish Night Dinner on Friday where we will be able to present them with our LAOH donations.

Our Appeals for Aid application process had a couple bumps but for the most part went smooth. We had a total of 24 applications. Thank you to the committee for joining the zoom call and providing feedback and recommendations moving forward. These will all be shared with the new M&C officer. Overall, it was a very productive meeting, you all made that possible, thank you.

Based on all the interactions and feedback received over my term I was able to create a welcome packet for the new Mission & Charities Officers to use as they are elected. The goal was to create a tool that would help make the transition smoother for them and the divisions, counties, states and national. It was emailed out to the current State Presidents and M&C officers and can also be found on the LAOH website.

I would like to thank you all again for the support you have given me over my term. I would also like to thank Sister Corona for all her support, guidance, and prayers; Angela Bennett and Lora Traggiai from the Columban's Office for their patience answering all my questions.

Special thanks to the members of the National Board and Past National Presidents for your mentorship and guidance, I appreciate all of you.
